John Doe was born Oct. 17, 1924 in Lethbridge. After finishing high school, he served in the Royal Canadian Air Force from 1943 to 1946. He was turned down as a pilot due to his hearing, but was accepted for aircrew training and instructed Mosquito aircrews. After his discharge, he graduated from the University of Alberta in Edmonton as a civil engineer and worked for the Canadian Pacific Railway here in Lethbridge for 40 years. He married Joanne and they had three children: Tom, Dick and Jane. Joe died Nov. 5, 1995.
